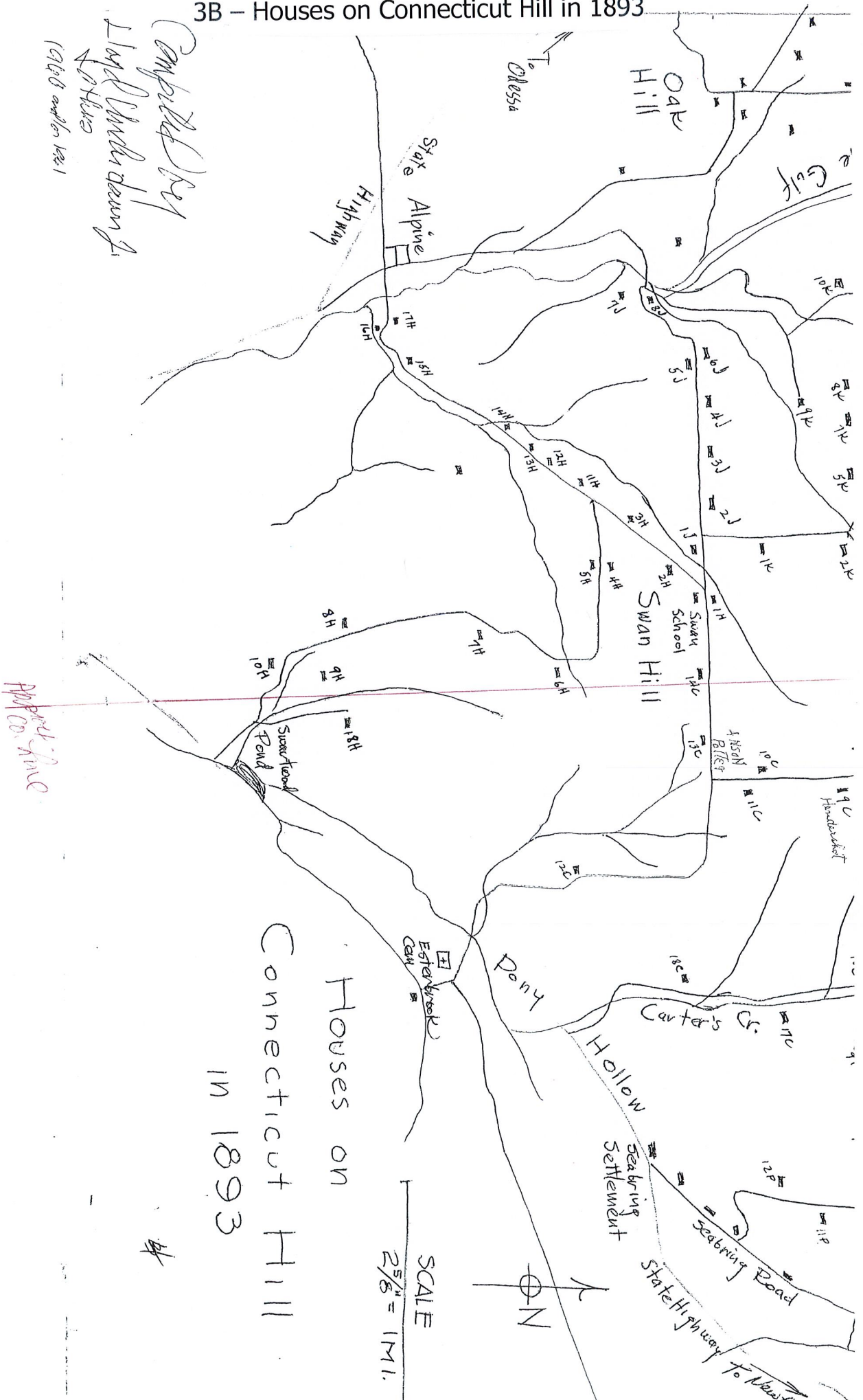


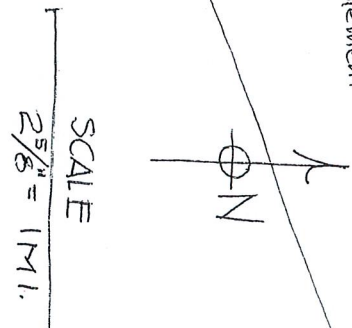
3B - Houses on Connecticut Hill in 1893



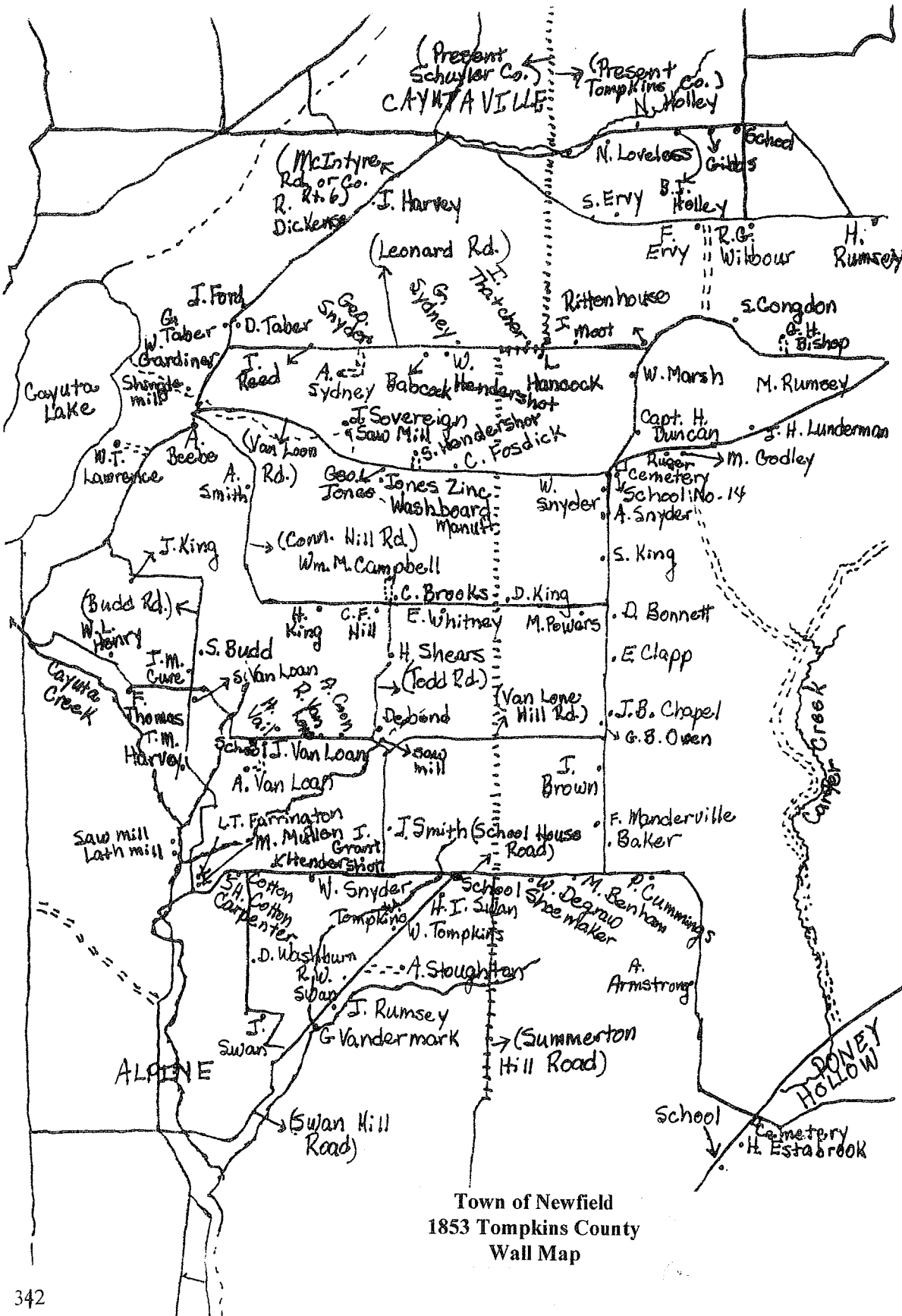

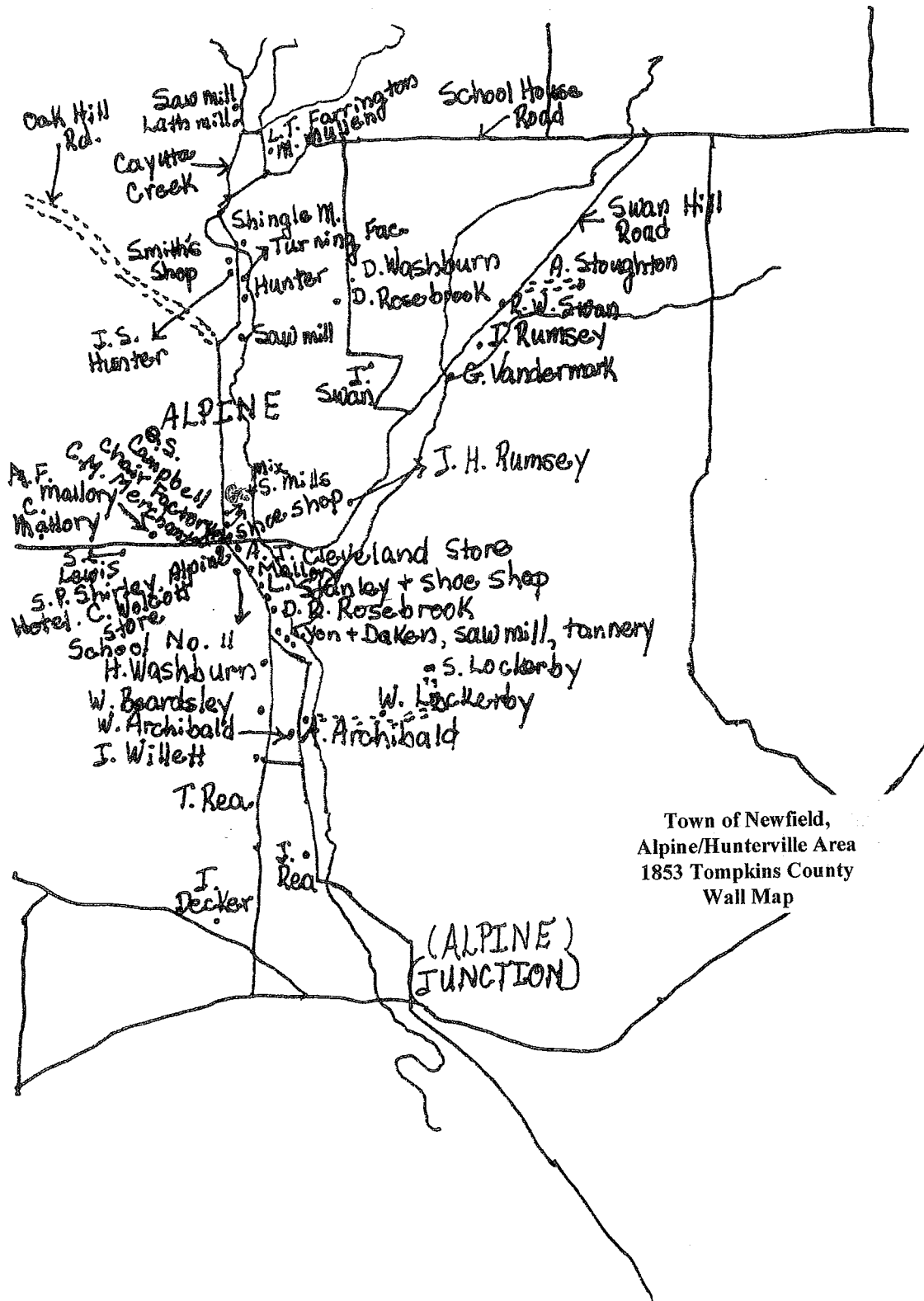

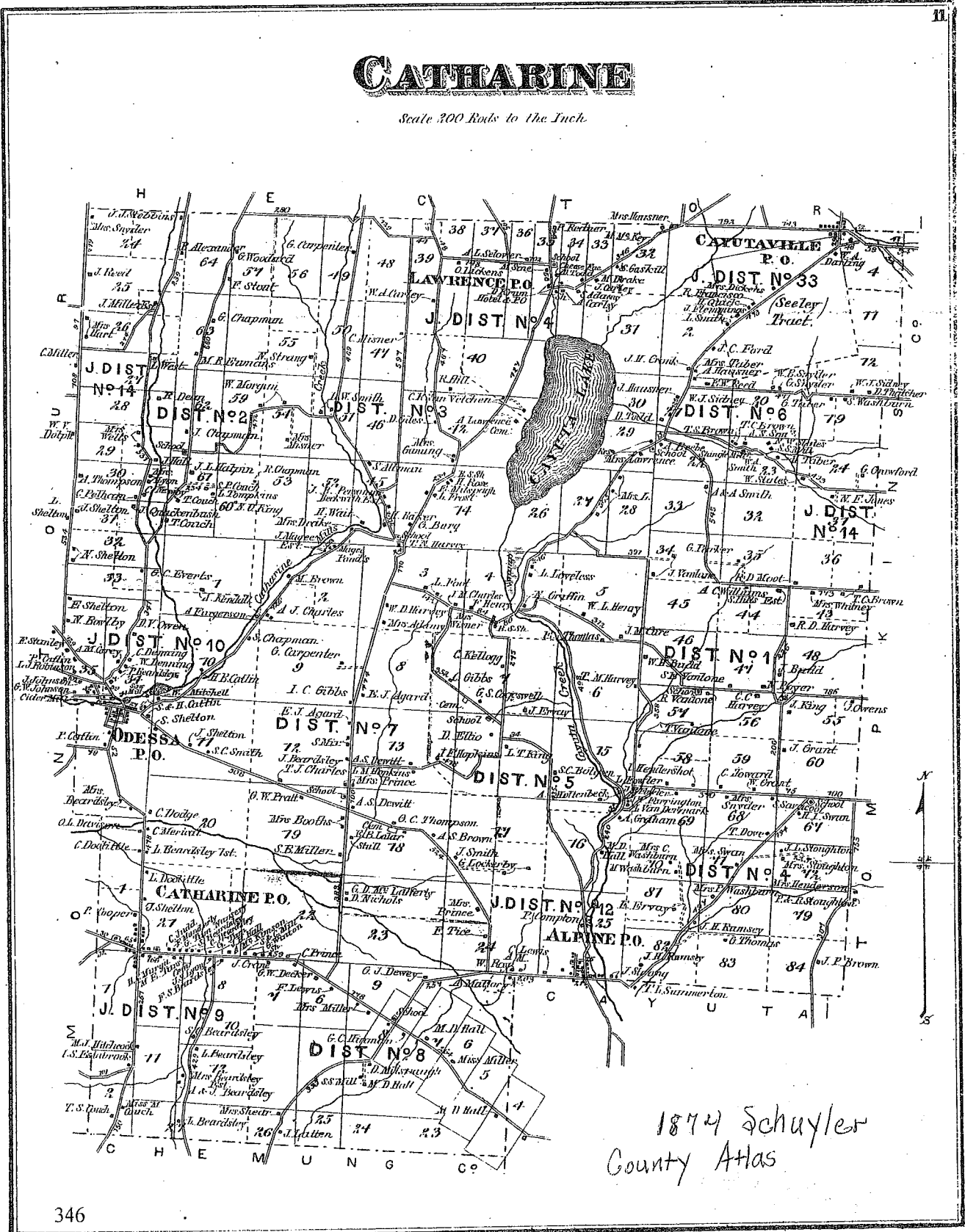

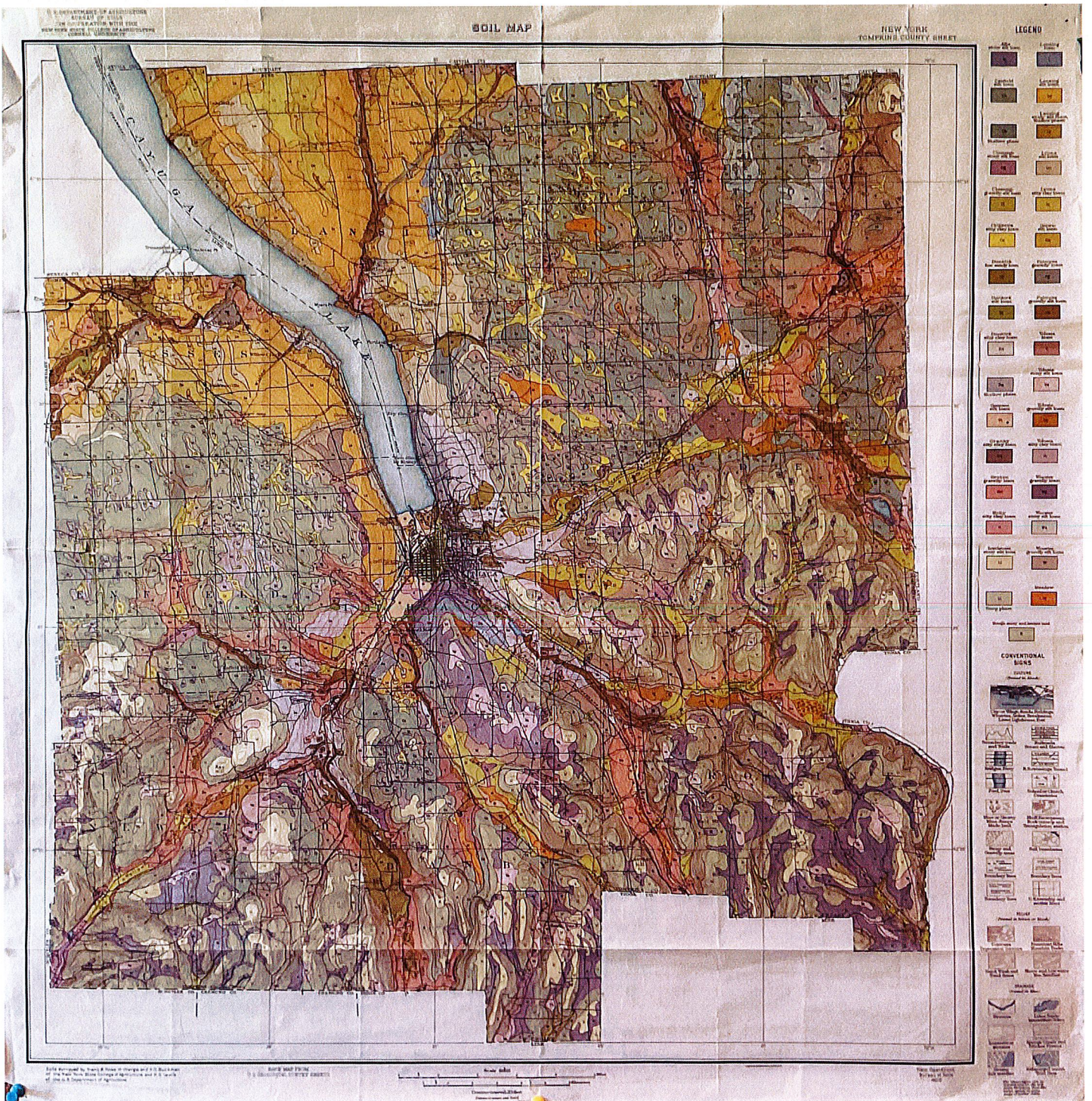

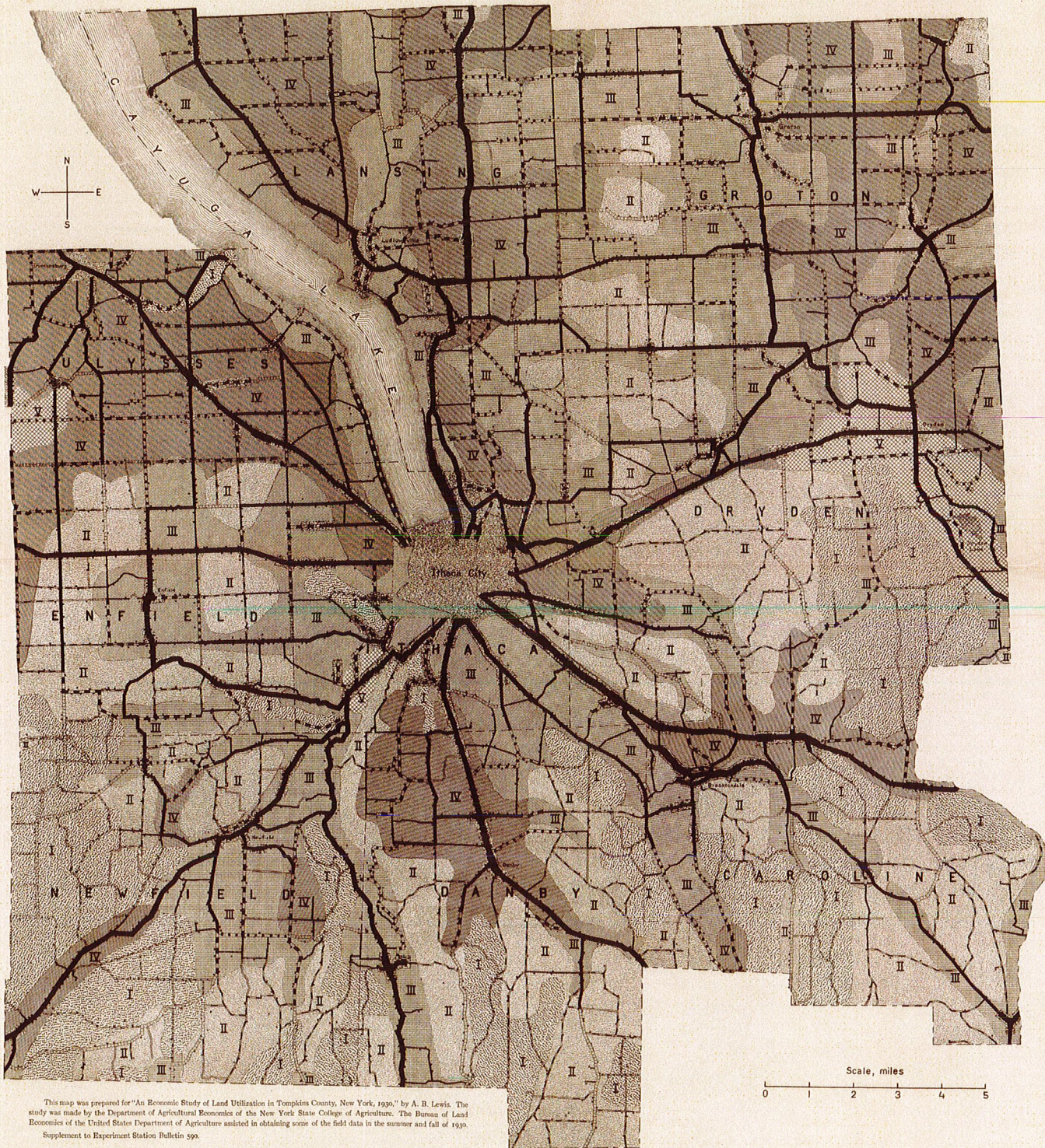


8A – Tompkins County Soil Map – 1920



8B – Tompkins County Land Use Map – 1930

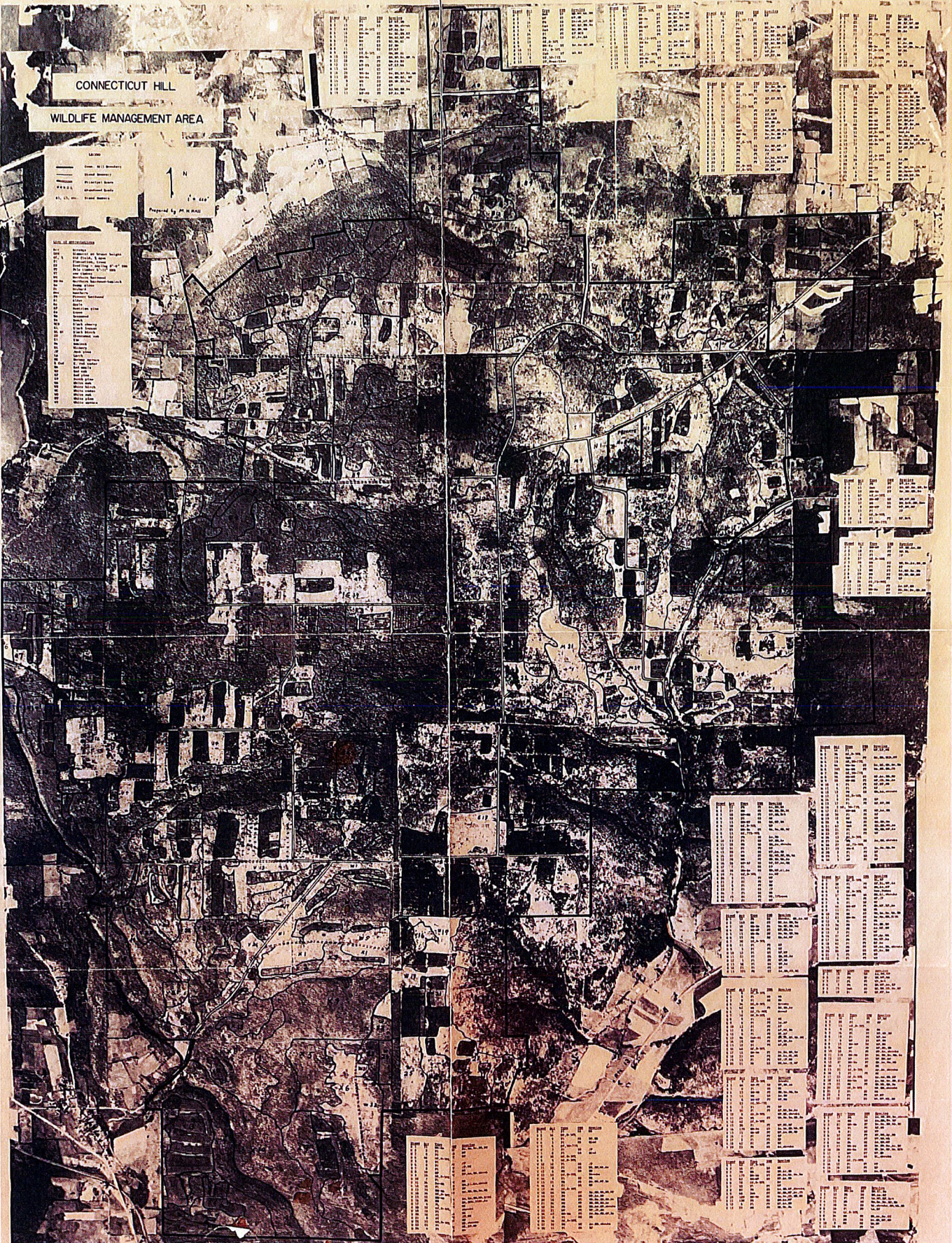
LAND CLASSIFICATION MAP OF TOMPKINS COUNTY, NEW YORK, 1930

11 - Property Map of Connecticut Hill Forest and Game Refuge - April, 1929

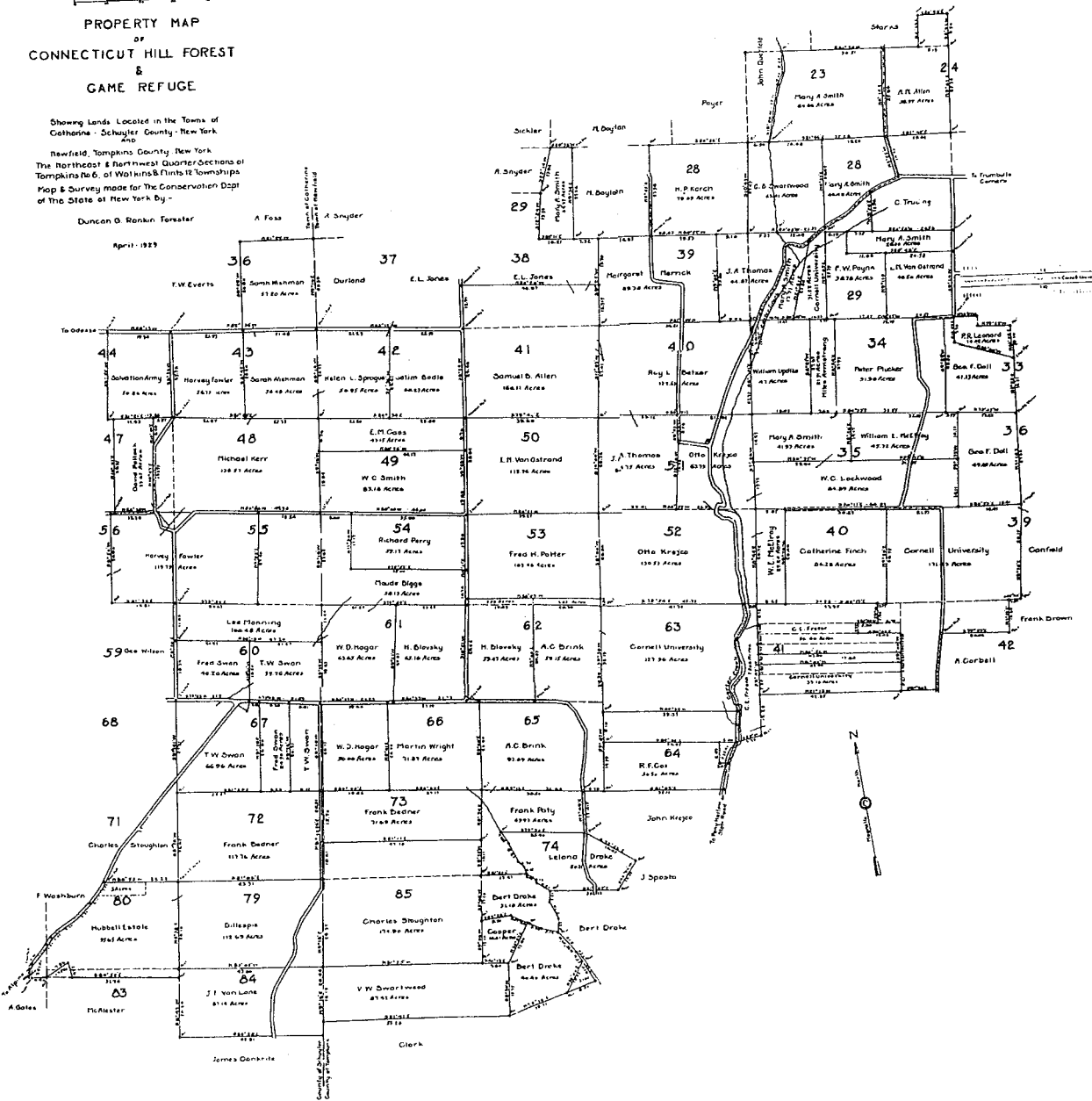

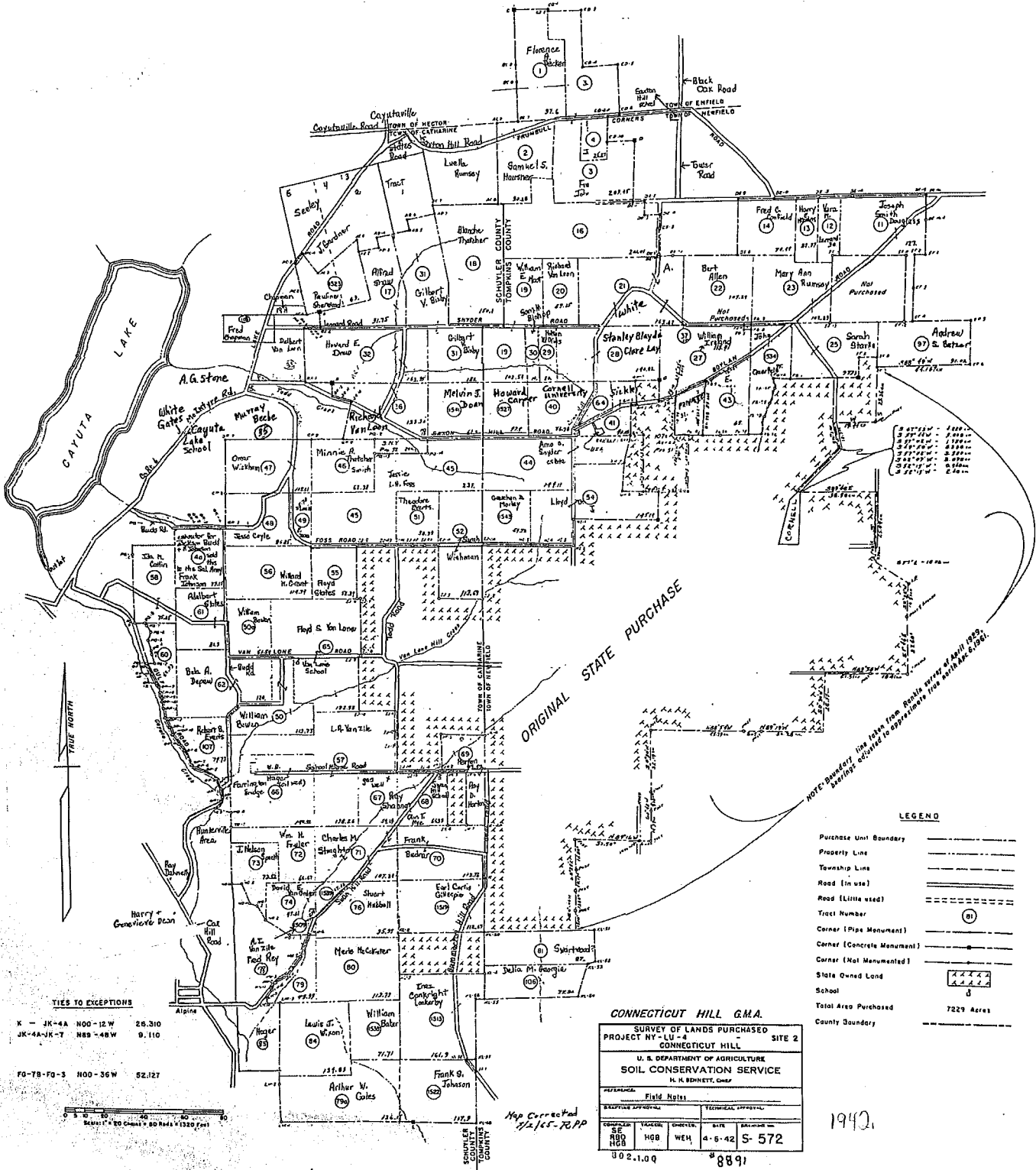

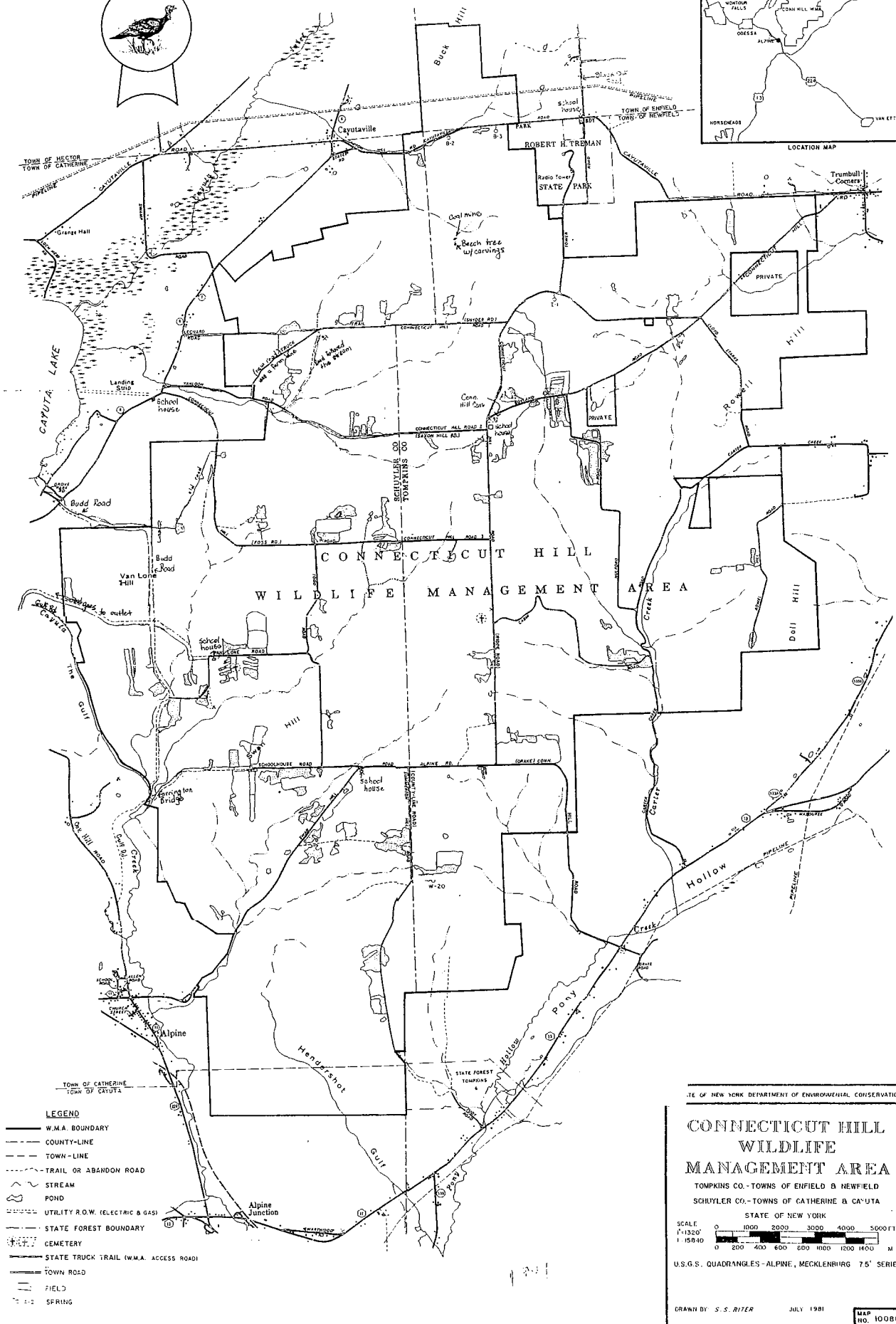
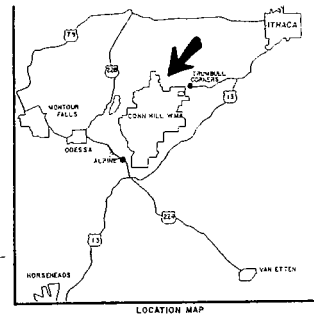
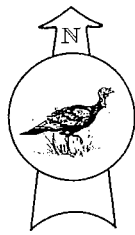

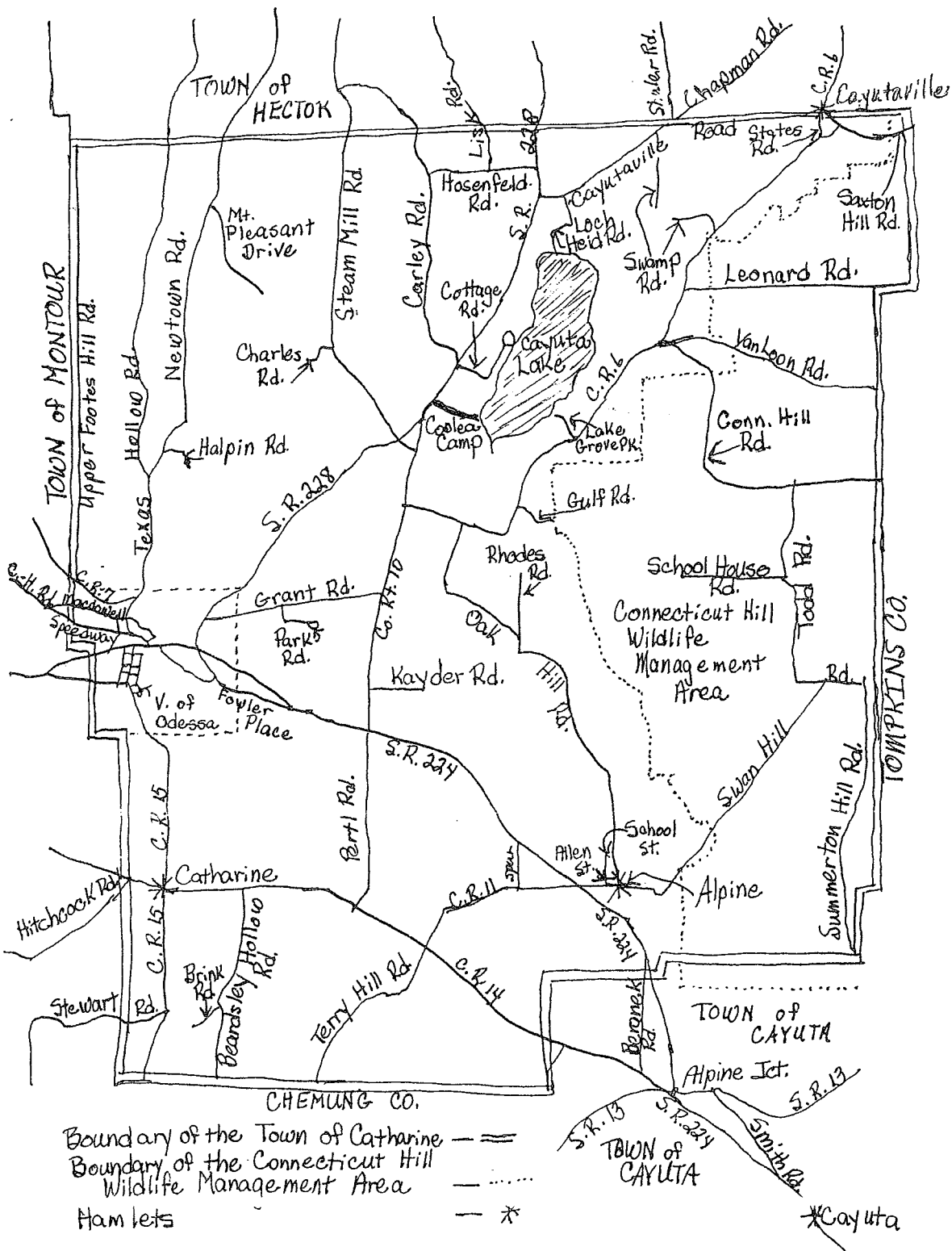
